### **ACTS OVERVIEW**

• A sequel to Luke's gospel, a crucial bridge to Paul's later writings. (Luke and Acts = 25% of NT). A helpful slide to show the continuum of Luke's writings:

LUKE		ACTS	Great Commission	>>> Ends of the Earth
Jesus birth	The gospel spreads through Jesus' earthly ministry	Pentecost	The gospel spreads though the Spirit empowered church	

- Provocative much is hard to understand
- Confidence an orderly account (Luke 1v1). Primarily theological. NB Speeches are abbreviated to give essence. Events are corroborated with Paul's accounts.
- Historical credibility indicating what the events signify. Cf. Lk 2v30-32, Author not just relaying the fact of Jesus' birth, but offering us the interpretation of this event. Acts is the same.

## A HELPFUL WAY TO DIVIDE THE BOOK:

Link with gospel, introduction, set-up, mission statement 1v8
Church in Jerusalem but spreading despite persecution. Stephen, first martyr
In Judea and Samaria (as Jesus said) Church becoming multi-ethnic and international
Missionary journeys. Clash of cultures. Jew/Gentile question
Paul in Rome, writing to churches from prison/house arrest

### THREE THINGS TO NOTICE

- 1. It is the <u>ACTS</u> of the Holy Spirit Holy Spirit is mentioned 57x.
  - Ask: What is the Holy Spirit doing? What is he saying? What is the Holy Spirit doing now?
- 2. *Nothing can stop the Gospel* Even during persecution the church spreads. Then as now. (Before cultural revolution the Chinese church was c. 100k now over 100m)
  - Ask: How can we help God?
- 3. *The good news is for everyone!* Acts emphasises the marginalised, the sick, the women. There was geographic and social spread (cf. Lk 8v41ff; Acts 10)
  - Ask: Do we believe that? Have we given up praying for someone?

### **BUILDING A COMMUNITY THAT STANDS**

"Stand" used 30x "Raised up" used 30x. Standing means we're ready, engaged, confident, with authority. Acts 2, 5 Peter Stands to speak; Acts 3, 9 Healings; Acts 7v56 Jesus stood for Stephen of Heb 12v2 etc. where Jesus is described as being seated in Heaven.

• How resilient are we as a community? How can we build resilience further?
